CURRICULAR DISTINCTIVES

FCS uses a curriculum that is distinctively Christian & academically challenging; Saxon's integrated mathematics curriculum which included Algebra I, Algebra II, Honors Geometry/Algebra III, Honors Pre-Calculus/Trigonometry and AP Calculus. Students who do not enroll in Honors Geometry/Algebra III are encouraged to take a separate geometry course. Consumer Math/Financial Planning is also offered. Senior Workshop is a class focusing on post-secondary financial guidance.

HONORS/AP CLASSES

Honors Course Offerings:

English 9, English 10, third year Foreign Language courses, Chemistry, Physics, Anatomy & Physiology, Geometry/Algebra III, Pre-Calculus/Trigonometry, World History, US History, and American Government/Economics.

Advancement Placement Course Offerings:

Calculus, English 11 and English 12.
