Applying for Tuition Assistance at FCS

The tuition assistance application process is now open to families who were enrolled at FCS in 2021-2022 and open to new families that have completed the application process and been granted acceptance .

If a family applies after considering the following guidelines and the amount of tuition assistance awarded is not adequate, please contact the Accounting Office to discuss possible options.

Students who have qualified for a voucher through the Wisconsin Parental Choice Program are not eligible for tuition assistance through FCS.

The following are some helpful guidelines and instructions for those who would like to apply.

- Assistance awarded can range from 5%-50% for those who qualify.*
- The tuition assistance program is designed to help families with the greatest financial need: the general expectation is that a family is encouraged to apply for tuition assistance if the total tuition cost for all enrolled students meets or exceeds 25% of the gross household income. For example:
 - The Smith Family is encouraged to apply because their total tuition cost is 25.1% of their gross household income.
 - Gross household income is \$81,190.
 - They have three kids: two in Elementary (a total of \$13,084), and one in Middle School (\$7,293) for a total tuition cost of \$20,377.
- This year, FCS will pay the fee on behalf of a family who applies.
- The deadline for Re-enrolling families is May 9th, 2022.

 - If you have applied for tuition assistance before, you may use your existing FACTS Payment Plan login.
 - If you haven't applied for tuition assistance in the past, you will need to create a new login account for the tuition assistance application.
