Payment Plans

Upon enrollment, there are three payment plan options.

1. 11 monthly electronic payments, processed on the 5th or 20th of each month, beginning July 2022.
2. Bi-annual payments with the first due by July 5, 2022 and the second due by December 5, 2022.
3. Payment in full due by July 5, 2022.

A 1% late fee will be assessed on all balances over 30 days. The Board of Directors reserves the right to withdraw a student(s) if a family is unable to fulfill their financial obligation in a timely manner.

Tuition Assistance

- Families with a financial need may apply for tuition assistance after the admissions application is submitted.
- Tuition assistance is also known as Grant & Aid/ Financial Aid in FACTS.
- There is no application fee.
- *Pre-K is not eligible for tuition assistance.*

Multi-student discount is based on the net tuition rate and will apply to the youngest student enrolled.

*If tuition assistance and discounts are granted, the family may choose whichever is greater.

High School Graduation Financial Policy

A student who has completed all graduation requirements, but whose tuition and/or fees are delinquent, will be permitted to walk at the graduation ceremony and receive a diploma, but will not receive transcripts until their account is paid in full.

Early Withdrawal/Dismissal Policy

Parents may choose to withdraw their student at any time and for any reason, but will remain accountable for their financial commitments. Likewise, Faith Christian School reserves the right to make choices about a student's enrollment or continued enrollment in school. If a student is withdrawn due to unforeseen circumstances, the family may appeal to the Board of Directors regarding any remaining balance.
