- **General Description**

- A teacher at Faith Christian School strives to use their giftedness and calling to consistently instruct and disciple FCS students in line with Scriptural principles, Christ-centered curriculum, and the mission and vision of Faith Christian School.

- **Responsibilities**

- Instruction: weekly lesson planning updated daily as necessary, effective teaching, and effective assessment of student learning. Adapt teaching methods to meet students' varying needs and interests.
- Communication: Christ-like and prompt communication with parents and colleagues.
- Duties: fulfillment of duties outside the classroom such as recess and lunch.
- Others as assigned by the Elementary Supervisor or other members of the Administrative Leadership Team.

- **Skill Sets Required**

- A growing understanding of sound, Christ-centered pedagogy.
- Strong communication skills in both written and oral presentation.
- Ability to develop rapport with students within a discipleship context.
- Ability to manage multiple assignments while working in an environment subject to frequent interruptions and meeting deadlines.
- Well-developed organizational and time-management skills.
- Understands the importance of confidentiality.
- Good judgment, experienced insight, a balanced perspective, a sense of humor, and an abiding good spirit.

- **Biblical Qualifications**

- A life that models a consistent daily walk with Jesus Christ, that serves as a Christian role model in speech, actions, and attitudes, and that contributes to the spiritual atmosphere of the school.
- Evidence the fruit of the Spirit in the nurturing of relationships with teachers and other staff members, students, families, and the community at large.
- The successful candidate must have a clear testimony of personal faith in Jesus Christ as Savior and must be able to demonstrate active membership and involvement in an evangelical local church.

- **Other Qualifications**

- A bachelor's degree is required; a Master's degree is preferred
- Technological literacy and proficiency (e.g., word processing, spreadsheets, email, internet, presentation software, and online grade book programs).
